



## Navigation Shortcuts

### Basic Navigation

<b>Cmd + Shift + C</b> : Open the Computer window. Quickly access all connected drives and devices.
<b>Cmd + Shift + D</b> : Open the Desktop folder. Instantly navigate to your desktop.
<b>Cmd + Shift + H</b> : Open the Home folder. Go directly to your user account's home directory.
<b>Cmd + Opt + L</b> : Open the Downloads folder. Quick access to your downloaded files.
<b>Cmd + Shift + O</b> : Open the Documents folder. Navigate to your documents folder.
<b>Cmd + Shift + I</b> : Open the iCloud Drive. Access your iCloud Drive directly from Finder.
<b>Cmd + Shift + K</b> : Open the Network window. Browse shared network resources.
<b>Cmd + Shift + U</b> : Open the Utilities folder. Quickly access system utilities.

## File Management Shortcuts

### Basic File Operations

<b>Cmd + N</b> : Open a new Finder window.
<b>Cmd + Shift + N</b> : Create a new folder.
<b>Cmd + D</b> : Duplicate the selected files.
<b>Cmd + DeI</b> : Move the selected item to the Trash.
<b>Cmd + Shift + DeI</b> : Empty the Trash.
<b>Cmd + Opt + Shift + DeI</b> : Empty the Trash without confirmation.
<b>Cmd + I</b> : Show the Get Info window for a selected file.

## Finder Window Options

### View and Display

<b>Cmd + Shift + P</b> : Show/hide the Preview pane.
<b>Cmd + Opt + P</b> : Hide or show the path bar.
<b>Cmd + Opt + S</b> : Hide or show the Sidebar.
<b>Cmd + /</b> : Hide or show the status bar.
<b>Cmd + J</b> : Show View Options.
<b>Cmd + T</b> : Show or hide the tab bar (single tab).
<b>Cmd + Opt + T</b> : Show/hide toolbar (single tab).

### Folder Navigation

<b>Cmd + Up</b>	Open the folder containing the current folder.
<b>Cmd + Ctrl + Up</b>	Open the folder containing the current folder in a new window.
<b>Cmd + Down</b>	Open the selected item.
<b>Cmd + [</b>	Go to the previous folder.
<b>Cmd + ]</b>	Go to the next folder.
<b>Right</b> (in list view)	Open the selected folder.
<b>Left</b> (in list view)	Close the selected folder.

### Advanced File Operations

<b>Cmd + Ctrl + A</b>	Make an alias of the selected item.
<b>Cmd + Opt + V</b>	Move files from their original location to the current location (after copying).
<b>Cmd + Y</b>	Use Quick Look to preview the selected files.
<b>Cmd + Opt + Y</b>	View a Quick Look slideshow of the selected files.
<b>Cmd + R</b>	Show the original file for a selected alias.
<b>Cmd + E</b>	Eject the selected disk or volume.

### View Modes

<b>Cmd + 1</b>	View items as icons.
<b>Cmd + 2</b>	View items as a list.
<b>Cmd + 3</b>	View items in columns.
<b>Cmd + 4</b>	View items in a gallery.

## System and Other Shortcuts

### System Shortcuts

<b>Cmd + Opt + D</b> : Show or hide the Dock.
<b>Cmd + Brightness Down</b> : Turn video mirroring on/off (multiple displays).
<b>Cmd + Brightness Up</b> : Open Displays preferences.
<b>Ctrl + Brightness</b> : Change external display brightness (if supported).
<b>Opt + Shift + Brightness</b> : Adjust brightness in smaller steps.
<b>Ctrl + Down</b> : Show all windows of the front app.
<b>Opt + Vol</b> : Open Sound preferences.

### Additional Finder Functions

<b>Cmd + F</b>	Start a Spotlight search in the Finder window.
<b>Cmd + Shift + G</b>	Open a 'Go to Folder' window.
<b>Cmd + Shift + R</b>	Open the AirDrop window.
<b>Cmd + K</b>	Open the 'Connect to Server' window.
<b>Ctrl + Cmd + Shift + T</b>	Add selected Finder items to the Dock.
<b>Cmd + Ctrl + T</b>	Add the selected item to the sidebar.
