

Markdown Basics & Tips

Quick Tips

Search for a specific note: Use <code>Ctrl + P</code> (Cmd + P on Mac).
Create internal links: Use <code>[[note name]]</code> .
Create external links: Use <code>[Text](URL)</code> .
For Bullet Points: Use <code>-</code> , <code>*</code> , or <code>1.</code>
For Headings: Use <code>#</code> (e.g., <code># Heading 1</code> , <code>## Heading 2</code>).
For Code Blocks: Wrap text in triple backticks <code>```</code> .
For Embeds: Use <code>![[note name]]</code> to embed another note.
Using the <code>Things theme</code> .

Advanced Markdown & Embeds

Links and Embeds

<code>[[Note Name]]</code>	Internal Link to another note.
<code>[[Note Name Custom Text]]</code>	Internal Link with display text.
<code>[Link Text](URL)</code>	External Link.
<code>![[Note Name]]</code>	Embed content of another note.
<code>![[Image.png]]</code>	Embed an image or other media.
<code>![[PDF.pdf#page=5]]</code>	Embed a specific page of a PDF.
<code>[[Note Name#Section]]</code>	Link to a specific section within a note.

Lists and Blockquotes

- Item 1   - Item 2	Unordered List (using <code>-</code> , <code>*</code> , or <code>+</code> )
- First item   - Second item	Ordered List
<input type="checkbox"/> Task item (unchecked)    <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Task item (checked)	Task List
"This is a quote."	Blockquote
"You can span multiple lines."	Multiline Blockquote
&gt; Quote  Paragraph	Blockquote followed by a paragraph (needs blank line)

Code Blocks and Tables

Wrap inline code in single backticks: `code`

Wrap code blocks in triple backticks:

```
print("Hello, World!")
```

Specify language for syntax highlighting:

```
print("Hello, World!")
```

Creating a table:

Header 1	Header 2
-----	-----
Cell 1	Cell 2
Cell 3	Cell 4

The second line (`| ----- | ----- |`) is mandatory.

General Shortcuts

File & Note Management

<b>Ctrl + S</b> (Cmd + S on Mac)	Saves the current file.
<b>Ctrl + N</b> (Cmd + N on Mac)	Creates a new note.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + D</b> (Cmd + Shift + D on Mac)	Create a Daily Note.
<b>Ctrl + W</b> (Cmd + W on Mac)	Close current tab/pane.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + W</b> (Cmd + Shift + W on Mac)	Close all tabs/panes.
<b>Ctrl + P</b> (Cmd + P on Mac)	Quick Search / Open command palette.

Navigation & Search

<b>Ctrl + O</b> (Cmd + O on Mac)	Opens Quick Switcher (search notes).
<b>Ctrl + Shift + F</b> (Cmd + Shift + F on Mac)	Search in all files.
<b>Ctrl + F</b> (Cmd + F on Mac)	Searches current file.
<b>Ctrl + H</b> (Cmd + H on Mac)	Find/Replace in current file.
<b>Ctrl + G</b> (Cmd + G on Mac)	Opens graph view.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + ←</b> (Cmd + Option + ← on Mac)	Navigate Back in history.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + →</b> (Cmd + Option + → on Mac)	Navigate Forward in history.
<b>Ctrl + ,</b> (Cmd + , on Mac)	Open Settings.

Pane & Tab Management

<b>Ctrl + Click</b> (Cmd + Click on Mac) on a Link	Open link in a new pane.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Click</b> (Cmd + Shift + Click on Mac) on a Link	Open link in a new pane (alternate).
<b>Ctrl + Tab</b>	Switch to next tab.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Tab</b>	Switch to previous tab.
<b>Ctrl + E</b> (Cmd + E on Mac)	Toggle Edit/Preview modes.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + E</b> (Cmd + Shift + E on Mac)	Toggle sidebar panels.

Editing Shortcuts

Text Manipulation

<b>Ctrl + B</b> (Cmd + B on Mac)	Bold selected text.
<b>Ctrl + I</b> (Cmd + I on Mac)	Italicize selected text.
<b>Ctrl + K</b> (Cmd + K on Mac)	Insert external link on selected text.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + K</b> (Cmd + Shift + K on Mac)	Insert internal link on selected text.
<b>Ctrl + M</b> (Cmd + M on Mac)	Insert image link.
<b>Ctrl + L</b> (Cmd + L on Mac)	Insert list item ( <b>-</b> ).
<b>Ctrl + Shift + L</b> (Cmd + Shift + L on Mac)	Insert numbered list item ( <b>1.</b> ).

Line & Block Operations

<b>Ctrl + ]</b> (Cmd + ] on Mac)	Indent line/selection.
<b>Ctrl + [</b> (Cmd + [ on Mac)	Unindent line/selection.
<b>Ctrl + D</b> (Cmd + D on Mac)	Delete current line.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Down Arrow</b> (Cmd + Shift + Down Arrow on Mac)	Duplicate current line/selection downwards.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Up Arrow</b> (Cmd + Shift + Up Arrow on Mac)	Duplicate current line/selection upwards.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + T</b> (Cmd + Shift + T on Mac)	Insert task list item ( <b>- [ ]</b> ).
<b>Ctrl + Alt + Down Arrow</b> (Cmd + Option + Down Arrow on Mac)	Move line/selection down.
<b>Ctrl + Alt + Up Arrow</b> (Cmd + Option + Up Arrow on Mac)	Move line/selection up.
