



## Shortcuts & Controls

### General App Shortcuts

Command+N	Create a new playlist
Command+O	Open a file
Command+P	Open Music Preferences
Command+Q	Quit Music
Command+Z	Undo last action
Command+Shift+Z	Redo last action
Command+W	Close window
Command+M	Minimize window
Command+H	Hide Music

### Playback Controls

Space bar	Play or Pause
Command+Right Arrow	Skip to next track
Command+Left Arrow	Skip to previous track
Option+Command+Right Arrow	Fast forward through current track
Option+Command+Left Arrow	Rewind through current track
Shift+Command+L	Show Lyrics
Command+R	Repeat song/album/playlist (toggle)
Option+Command+R	Shuffle (toggle)
Command+Option+3	Switch to MiniPlayer

## Library & Navigation

### Navigation & Views

Command+1	View Library
Command+2	View Browse
Command+3	View Radio
Command+4	View Store
Command+, (Comma)	Open Preferences
Command+F	Search your library
Command+L	Show currently playing song in library
Control+G	Go to current song's artist
Shift+Control+G	Go to current song's album

### Library Actions

Delete key	Delete selected item
Command+I	Get Info for selected item(s)
Command+A	Select All items in current view
Shift+Click	Select a range of items
Command+Click	Select/Deselect individual items
Drag & Drop	Add items to playlists, sync devices, etc.
Control+Click	Open contextual menu for more options
Option+Click on 'Add to Library' button	Adds entire album/playlist to library without adding to 'Recently Added'
Command+D	Deselect all items

## Tips & Tricks

### Smart Playlists

<b>Automate Library Organization:</b> Use <code>File &gt; New &gt; Smart Playlist...</code> to create playlists based on rules (e.g., genre, rating, last played). They update automatically.
<b>Combine Rules:</b> Add multiple rules using 'Match \any/all\ of the following rules'. Use nested rules for complex logic.
<b>Limit Size:</b> Set limits on the number of songs, total time, or disk space for the playlist.
<b>Example:</b> Create a Smart Playlist for 'Songs liked in the last 30 days with 5 stars that haven't been played recently'.
<b>Live Updating:</b> Ensure 'Live updating' is checked for the playlist to automatically add/remove songs as they match the rules.
<b>Backup:</b> Smart playlist rules can be exported and imported (though less straightforward than standard playlists).
<b>Use Play Count:</b> Track songs you listen to most by creating a playlist based on play count.
<b>Rating System:</b> Utilize the star rating system ( <code>Song &gt; Rating</code> ) to feed into Smart Playlists.
<b>Last Played/Skipped:</b> Create lists of songs you've recently played or skipped to manage your preferences.

## Sound & Playback Settings

**Equalizer:** Access the Equalizer via `Window > Equalizer`. Use presets or create your own to tailor sound output.

**Sound Enhancer:** Found in `Music > Preferences... > Playback`. Slightly boosts bass and treble for a 'richer' sound.

**Crossfade Songs:** Located in `Music > Preferences... > Playback`. Smoothly transition between tracks.

**Sound Check:** Normalizes volume levels across different songs. Also in `Music > Preferences... > Playback`.

**High-Quality Playback:** Ensure you have 'Lossless Audio' and 'Dolby Atmos' enabled in `Music > Preferences... > Playback` if you are an Apple Music subscriber and have compatible hardware.

**Audio Quality Settings (Mobile):** On iOS/iPadOS, set streaming and download quality in `Settings > Music > Audio Quality`.

**Reducing Storage:** On mobile, use 'Optimize Storage' (`Settings > Music > Optimize Storage`) to automatically delete downloaded songs you haven't played recently.

**Playback Destinations:** Use the AirPlay/Output icon (top bar) to stream music to different speakers or devices.

**Gapless Playback:** Apple Music supports gapless playback by default for albums that require it.

## Using Widgets & MiniPlayer

**MiniPlayer (macOS):** Switch using `Command+Option+3` or `Window > Switch to MiniPlayer`. A small, unobtrusive window for basic controls.

**MiniPlayer Controls:** Hover to see playback buttons, volume, and now playing info. Click album art to return to the main window.

**Adding Widgets (macOS Desktop):** Right-click desktop, select 'Edit Widgets', drag Music widget to desktop.

**Widget Sizes:** Choose between small (currently playing), medium (currently playing + recent), and large (currently playing + more recent).

**Adding Widgets (iOS/iPadOS):** Long press on home screen, tap '+', search for Music, choose size, and add.

**Widget Functionality:** Widgets provide quick access to playback controls and recently played/suggested music without opening the app.

**Lock Screen Player:** Basic playback controls are always available on the lock screen when music is playing.

**Control Center:** Access Music controls quickly from Control Center on iOS/iPadOS and macOS.
