#### Text Styles

[b]Bold text[/b]	<b>Result:</b> Bold text
[i]Italic text[/i]	<b>Result:</b> <i>Italic text</i>
[u]Underlined text[/u]	<b>Result:</b> Underlined text
[s]Strikethrough text[/s]	<b>Result:</b> Strikethrough text
[sup]Superscript text[/sup]	<b>Result:</b> Superscript text textSuperscript text
[sub]Subscript text[/sub]	<b>Result:</b> Subscript text textSubscript text

#### Text Colors

[color=red]Red text[/color]	<b>Result:</b> Red text
[color=#00FF00]Green text[/color]	<b>Result:</b> Green text
[color=blue]Blue text[/color]	<b>Result:</b> Blue text

#### Text Sizes

[size=1]Tiny text[/size]	<b>Result:</b> Tiny text
[size=3]Normal text[/size]	<b>Result:</b> Normal text
[size=7]Huge text[/size]	<b>Result:</b> Huge text

### Links and Images

#### Hyperlinks

[url] <a href="https://example.com/">https://example.com/</a> [/url]	<b>Result:</b> <a href="https://example.com/">https://example.com</a>
[url=https://example.com]Example Website[/url]	<b>Result:</b> <a href="https://example.com">Example Website</a>

#### Images

[img] <a href="https://example.com/image.jpg">https://example.com/image.jpg</a> [/img]	<b>Result:</b> Display an image from the specified URL. Note: actual image display depends on the platform's BBCode implementation.

### Lists and Quotes

#### Lists

[list] [li>Item 1 [li>Item 2 [/list]	<b>Result:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Item 1</li> <li>• Item 2</li> </ul>
[list=1] [li>Item A [li>Item B [/list]	<b>Result:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Item A</li> <li>2. Item B</li> </ol>
[list=a] [li>Item X [li>Item Y [/list]	<b>Result:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Item X</li> <li>b. Item Y</li> </ol>

#### Quotes

[quote]Quoted text[/quote]	<b>Result:</b> Displays the text as a quotation.
[quote=Author]Quoted text with author[/quote]	<b>Result:</b> Displays the text as a quotation, attributed to the specified author.

### Code and Other Formatting

#### Code Blocks

[code]This is some code. [/code]	<b>Result:</b> Displays the text as a code block. The exact appearance depends on the platform implementation.  Example: <pre>This is some code.</pre>
[code=php]Example: [code]<?php echo 'Hello, world!'; ?>[/code]	<b>Result:</b> Displays the code with syntax highlighting (if supported by the platform).  Example: <pre>&lt;?php echo 'Hello, world!'; ?&gt;</pre>

#### Alignment

[align=center]Centered Text[/align]	<b>Result:</b> Centers the text horizontally. Support may vary across platforms.
[align=right]Right-aligned Text[/align]	<b>Result:</b> Aligns the text to the right. Support may vary across platforms.

#### Line Breaks

BBCode generally recognizes standard line breaks (i.e., pressing 'Enter' in your text editor). If not, manual line breaks are usually not supported directly via a BBCode tag. Instead, platforms typically handle line breaks automatically.
