



Text Formatting

Basic Styles

<code>*Italics*</code>	Renders text in <i>italics</i> .
<code>**Bold**</code>	Renders text in bold .
<code>***Bold Italics***</code>	Renders text in <i>bold italics</i> .
<code>--Strikethrough--</code>	Renders text with a strikethrough .
<code>__Underline__</code>	Renders text with an <u>underline</u> . (Note: Support varies by wiki.)
<code>' 'Italics'</code>	Alternative syntax for <i>italics</i> (MediaWiki).
<code>' 'Bold'</code>	Alternative syntax for bold (MediaWiki).
<code>' ' 'Bold Italics'</code>	Alternative syntax for <i>bold italics</i> (MediaWiki).

Headings

<code>= Heading 1 =</code>	Creates a Heading 1.
<code>== Heading 2 ==</code>	Creates a Heading 2.
<code>=== Heading 3 ===</code>	Creates a Heading 3.
<code>==== Heading 4 ====</code>	Creates a Heading 4.
<code>===== Heading 5 =====</code>	Creates a Heading 5.
<code>===== Heading 6 =====</code>	Creates a Heading 6.

Horizontal Rule

<code>----</code>	Creates a horizontal rule (line).
<code><hr></code>	Alternative HTML tag for a horizontal rule.

Lists and Links

Unordered Lists

<code>* Item 1</code>	Creates an unordered (bulleted) list.
<code>• Item 2</code>	
<code>** Item 1 **</code>	Creates nested unordered lists.

Ordered Lists

<code># Item 1</code>	Creates an ordered (numbered) list.
<code>Item 2</code>	
<code>Item 1</code>

<code>## Item 1</code>	Creates nested ordered lists.
<code>Item 2</code>

<code>## Item 1 ##</code>	Creates a mixed list (ordered and unordered).

Internal Links

<code>[[Page Name]]</code>	Links to a page within the same wiki.
<code>[[Page Name Link Text]]</code>	Links to a page with custom link text.

External Links

<code>[https://www.example.com]</code>	Creates an external link with the URL as the text.
<code>[https://www.example.com Link Text]</code>	Creates an external link with custom link text.
<code>https://www.example.com</code>	Some wikis automatically convert URLs to links.

Tables and Code

Tables

<code>{ </code>	Table start and end markers. (MediaWiki)
<code> }</code>	
<code> + Table Caption</code>	Adds a caption to the table. (MediaWiki)
<code> -</code>	Indicates a new row in the table. (MediaWiki)
<code> Cell content</code>	Adds a cell to the current row. (MediaWiki)
<code>!</code>	Cell header start marker. (MediaWiki)
<code> style="text-align:center;" Cell content</code>	Adds style to the cell. (MediaWiki)
<code> Cell content</code>	Another cell in the same row. (MediaWiki)

Code Blocks

<code><code>Code here</code></code>	For inline code.
<code><pre>Code here</pre></code>	Creates a preformatted code block.
<code><syntaxhighlight lang="language">Code here</syntaxhighlight></code>	Highlights code with specific language syntax. (MediaWiki extension)
<code>Code here</code>	Markdown style code blocks (if supported by the wiki).

Blockquotes

<code>> Blockquote</code>	Creates a blockquote (if supported).
<code><blockquote>Blockquote</blockquote></code>	HTML style blockquote.

Advanced Formatting

Images

<code>[[Image:Example.jpg]]</code>	Embeds an image (MediaWiki).
<code>[[Image:Example.jpg alt=Alternative text]]</code>	Adds alternative text to the image (MediaWiki).
<code>[[Image:Example.jpg thumb Caption text]]</code>	Adds a thumbnail with caption (MediaWiki).
<code>[[Image:Example.png 200px]]</code>	Resizes the image to 200 pixels wide (MediaWiki).

Redirects

<code>#REDIRECT [[Target Page]]</code>	Redirects to another page (MediaWiki).

Ignoring Wiki Markup

<code><nowiki>Markup here</nowiki></code>	Ignores wiki markup within the tags.

Special Characters

<code>&lt;</code>	Displays <code><</code> .
<code>&gt;</code>	Displays <code>></code> .
<code>&amp;</code>	Displays <code>&</code> .
<code>&quot;</code>	Displays <code>"</code> .
<code>&apos;</code>	Displays <code>'</code> .
